#### Key achievements:

- Consolidation of multiple data sources and business processes into a corporate solution with a single integrated asset database
- Collaborative, integrated approach to SHQS surveying and reporting
- Strategic management of Council's housing and corporate assets

North Lanarkshire is the fourth largest of Scotland's 32 local authorities. It lies midway between Glasgow and Edinburgh, and contains much of Glasgow's suburbs and commuter towns and villages.

In August 2013 Manhattan Atrium won the contract to supply, install and maintain the Council's property asset management system.

A notable aspect of this contract is that the Atrium EAM solution enables North Lanarkshire Council to undertake the strategic management of its housing stock of some 37,000 properties, as well as more than 4,000 corporate properties ranging from high schools to areas of derelict land.

In particular, the Atrium EAM solution enables North Lanarkshire Council to:

- Undertake capital asset investment planning (CAIP) tools using "what-if" scenarios covering works and budgets

- Formulate 30 year business plans informed by an evidence-based decisions using the CAIP tools
- Demonstrate compliance with national standards such as the Scottish Housing Quality Standards (SHQS) and locally defined standards
- Maintain a record of equipment servicing and inspection schedules with alerts for key dates
- Deliver better planned maintenance by allowing management of contracts and analysis of budget versus works
- Fulfil legal obligations with regard to asbestos management and risk assessments
- Use handheld technology for surveying
- Interface to other Council systems, including GIS
- Undertake suitability, condition, utilisation and DDA surveys
- Manage property revenue expenditure and valuation details



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Phase I of the project began in late 2013 with the configuration of the hosting environments and a series of workshops for the Portfolio, Works and Assessment modules with data migration a key discussion. This was quickly followed by the population of the asset database, the specification of the interface to the Council's Housing Services Management System (HSMS), and a series of training courses.

Following the successful go-live of Phase I, implementation continues to move forward a pace. Phase 2 sees collaboration between the Council, Manhattan Atrium and Kirona (who supply the Council's strategic mobile work software). An interface between the Atrium EAM Assessments module (which includes

Scottish Housing Quality Standard (SHQS), Condition and Specialist surveys) and Kirona's DRS software ensures that every 230 question SHQS survey is properly scheduled. The data is gathered on a mobile device, and the results downloaded, validated and accepted back into Assessments, where SHQS reports are generated.

The next phases of this major project see the implementation of the Estates module to manage the Council's corporate properties, and Works, covering Reactive Maintenance and PPM. These will be followed by Performance, Modelling, Forecasting and Programming, as Manhattan Atrium continues to assist the Council with its strategic as well as operational asset management functions.

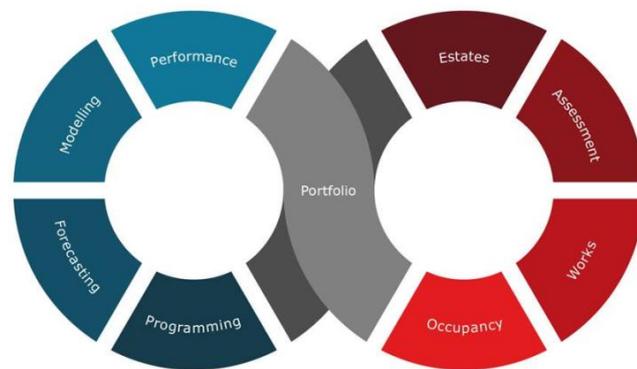
